Discover The Village of St. Martins

Heart of the Bay of Fundy

Nestled on miles of quiet, unspoiled beaches, the serene village of St. Martins is the gateway to the spectacular Fundy Trail. It was from the beaches of St. Martins that 500 sailing ships were built and launched in the golden age of sail. The history of this era is recorded for visitors at the Quaco Museum. The shipbuilders left a magnificent architectural legacy in their homes throughout the village.

Rising around the village are red sea cliffs and caves where the highest tides in the world sweep in and out. As the tide recedes, walk the ocean floor into the sea caves. Colourful fishing boats sit in the mud at low tide in the village harbour, which is encircled by two covered bridges, the lighthouse and Public Gardens. Salt marshes on the outer edge of the village provide wonderful opportunities for bird watching.

St. Martins is a magnet for artists and photographers wishing to capture the unspoiled beauty of the area. Opportunities for hiking, walking, biking, rock hounding, kayaking and beachcombing are all within steps of comfortable accommodation, campgrounds, B&Bs, cottages and luxurious country inns. Visitors to the village can enjoy a range of dining experiences, which include fresh Bay of Fundy seafood. A growing number of unique shops and galleries provide excellent shopping opportunities. Hiking, biking and kayaking tours and pony rides provide a range of activities for families. Golfers can enjoy a choice of five golf courses within a 45-minute drive.
